The soccer season is defined as follows:

- U9 March 15 – December 15
 - U10 March 15- December 15
 - U11 – U13 March 15 – February
 - U14 – U18 May – April
- (High School Break mid Aug, Sept, & Oct for U15 – U18)

Santa Rosa United dues are similar to tuition. They are not optional. If you are unable to attend a tournament or train for any reason including illness or injuries (except as noted below), no refund is due. No adjustment or reduction in Club Dues is allowed. Players who suffer serious injuries lasting more than three months, however, may submit a request to the SRU Board of release of payment of Dues for that period.

Dues Payment Options

Club Dues are paid directly to Santa Rosa United, and may be paid by cash, check or credit card (credit card payment can be made directly from your emailed invoice or by calling the SRU office). Players can also sign up for automatic payments at registration. Below are 3 payment options. Each player will need to choose an option when they register and then make the payments according to the option plan they choose.

Option 1: Pay annual Club Dues in full on or before:

All payments made in full at Registration can reduce the annual fee by \$20.

Allow you to pay your annual dues in monthly payments

- By registering with SRU you agree to make your monthly payment amount by the 1st of each month listed on this agreement whether or not you receive a SRU invoice or any other notice regarding your payment.
- As a courtesy SRU will email each player a monthly invoice for their payment.
- You can make your monthly payment installments directly from your SRU monthly invoice OR mail a check to SRU P.O. Box 12154 Santa Rosa, CA 95406
- In addition, a **late fee of \$15** will be assessed to any player 10 days past due on their installment payment. (There will be a \$30 Fee for each returned check).
- Players can sign up for automatic payments at registration. (you must fill out the appropriate form and turn in with your registration)

U9 - \$245 due at Registration March 11

- 9 payments of \$50 due April 1, May 1, June 1, July 1, Aug 1, Sept. 1, Oct 1, Nov 1, Dec 1.
- A late fee of \$15 will be assessed to any player 10 days past due

U10 - \$295 due at Registration March 11

- 9 payments of \$50 due April 1, May 1, June 1, July 1, Aug 1, Sept. 1, Oct 1, Nov 1, Dec 1.
- A late fee of \$15 will be assessed to any player 10 days past due

U11 - \$300 due at Registration March 11

- 10 payments of \$90 due April 1, May 1, June 1, July 1, Aug 1, Sept. 1, Oct 1, Nov 1, Dec 1, Jan 1
- A late fee of \$15 will be assessed to any player 10 days past due

U12 - \$300 due at Registration March 11

- 10 payments of \$90 due April 1, May 1, June 1, July 1, Aug 1, Sept. 1, Oct 1, Nov 1, Dec 1, Jan 1
- A late fee of \$15 will be assessed to any player 10 days past due

U13 - \$340 due at Registration March 11

- 11 payments of \$95 due April 1, May 1, June 1, July 1, Aug 1, Sept. 1, Oct 1, Nov 1, Dec 1, Jan 1, Feb 1
- A late fee of \$15 will be assessed to any player 10 days past due



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U14 - \$475 due at Registration March 11

- 11 payments of \$95 due May 1, June 1, July 1, Aug 1, Sept 1, Oct 1, Nov 1, Dec 1, Jan 1, Feb 1, March 1
- A late fee of \$15 will be assessed to any player 10 days past due

U15 – U18 \$475 due at Registration April 15

- 11 payments of \$95 due June 1, July 1, Aug 1, Sept 1, Oct 1, Nov 1, Dec 1, Jan 1, Feb 1, March 1, April 1
- A late fee of \$15 will be assessed to any player 10 days past due

Option 3: Pay in Four Installments

- By registering with SRU you agree to make the 4 listed payments by the due date listed on this agreement whether or not you receive a SRU invoice or any other notice regarding your payment.
- As a courtesy SRU will email each player an invoice for their payment.
- You can make your payment installments directly from your SRU invoice OR mail a check to SRU P.O. Box 12154 Santa Rosa, CA 95406
- In addition, **a late fee of \$15** will be assessed to any player 10 days past due on their installment payment. (There will be a \$30 Fee for each returned check).

Payment Default

Santa Rosa United is a membership organization. Unpaid dues represent funds not available to meet Club expenses. Any player delinquent in dues by 10 days or more will be notified by the Club and suspended from participating in any Club/team activity.

Volunteer U11 - U18

Every player’s family is required to volunteer time to help run the Club. This would include team jobs and snack bar shifts.

Snack Bar: Each player’s family will be obligated to work shifts at the SRU snack bar according to the snack bar schedule. This schedule will be given out each year to the SRU teams.

Team Jobs: Each player’s family will be required to sign up for a team job at the 1st team meeting. Managers will have a list of the team jobs

Optional Club Volunteer Positions: Families can volunteer for a club Job which are Manager, Team Treasurer, Board Member, or member of the Board of Director’s designated club committees. Each player can receive a onetime \$100 credit when volunteering for one of the optional club volunteer positions listed (this does not include snack bar or team jobs).



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Trione Field Fund – for repair and maintenance

U9 - U11 Field Fund \$50 per player

U12 -U18 Field Fund \$110 per player

We encourage players to participate in two fund-raisers for the field fund. Each player needs to raise the appropriate amount listed for their age group. Players who fall short of this amount will be billed by the club. Total amount must be turned in by June 1, 2010. Any player who does not want to participate in the fund-raiser can make the appropriate amount donation at the time of registration.

Information on both fund-raisers will be available when you sign up for Human Race and See's Candy.

Team Expenses

The Club Dues do not cover team expenses, which include but are not limited to, tournament entry fees, field rental fees, referee fees, team equipment and supplies, league fees, camp fees and coaches traveling expenses. Teams will collect team fees according to their team financial policy. Players not paying team fees within 10 days of the assessment due date will be subject to being suspended from participating in any Club/team activity.

Release Policy

For whatever reason, if a player quits or wishes to be released from the Club, a refund check will be drawn as per the club policy. We do not pro-rate for days in a month. For the drop initiated by a member to be effective the CYSA Release/Transfer or USClub release must be filled out with the Club Registrar. Players who have an outstanding balance with the team or club will not be released from SRU until the outstanding balance is paid in full.

Allocation of Dues to Services Provided by Santa Rosa United

Items paid for by your dues include: Coaching, Trainings, Certain League Fees, Club Administration Expenses (insurances, communications, document management, etc.), Field Maintenance and Usage, Registration, Referee Assignments and Mentoring.

Please note that services listed above are not all inclusive. A tremendous amount of work is performed, much of it by volunteers, in addition to the noted services.



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Additional Information

Special Note 1: Club policy is to allow Coaches to train more than one of the club's teams. Therefore it is inevitable that team Coaches will on occasion be unable to attend certain games. Every effort will be made by the Club to arrange for a suitable alternative Staff Member to coach the team.

Special Note 2: Club soccer is a competitive environment. Efforts are made to attract quality soccer players during tryouts and throughout the year. Rosters can and will change.

The above are part of United soccer and do not affect a family's commitment to pay the Club Dues when due.
