CLUB OVERVIEW

Santa Rosa United is a Division 1 competitive soccer club operating within the Santa Rosa Youth Soccer League (part of the California Youth Soccer Assoc. - North) and U.S. Club Soccer. Santa Rosa United is for players whose desire, natural ability and passion for the game, make them want to develop their soccer ability to the highest level possible. United teams achieve these goals through:

- Excellent coaching by a professional coaching staff
- Separate boys and girls coaching directors
- Top-level competition with other players of equal ability throughout California and beyond
- Participation in the playing leagues, including CYSA-North, NorCal, and U.S. Club leagues, as well as Olympic Development Program and Player Development Program participation by individual players

Expectations for Santa Rosa United teams are high, but this is NOT "win at all cost" soccer. The success of our teams is measured by the development and growth of its participants, not by wins and losses.

PERTINENT INFORMATION

Annual Club Fee:

The annual club fee includes registration expenses. There are three payment options to select from.

Volunteer Credit:

You may be able to receive \$100 credit or refund upon completion of approved volunteer service.

Field Assessment Fee (Trione replacement fund):

To help maintain fields for SRU the club has adopted a field assessment fee for the 2010-2011 season (U9 - U11 \$50 per player, U12 - U18 \$110 per player) due June 1, 2010. There are several club sponsored fund-raisers if you prefer to raise this fee or you can opt to pay at registration.

Team Expenses:

Various team expenses are paid equally between all team members. Annual team expenses per player range from \$400-\$800 depending on team tournaments. Team expenses include, but not limited to, tournament entry fees, field rental fees, referee fees, team equipment and supplies, league fees, camp fees and coach travel expenses.

Uniforms:

All players purchase NIKE uniforms, warm-ups and a soccer bag, along with practice T-shirts.

Registration:

Santa Rosa Youth Soccer League/CYSA-North and US Club Soccer fees are included with the annual club fee.

Travel Expenses:

Costs associated with tournament travel are the responsibility of each player's family.

Fund Raising:

Each team offers a variety of fund raising opportunities throughout the year to offset costs.

U11-U14 TENTATIVE SCHEDULE

March:

- Tryouts & team selection
- First team meetings
- U11 - U13 practice starts March 15

April-May

- NorCal Spring League
- U14 practice starts in May
- Possible tournaments

June:

- Practice 2-3x/week
- Tournament competitions

July-December:

- Practice 2-3x/week, possibly 1-2 tournament competitions
- *NOTE: A 2-week summer break will be given in either July or Aug., depending on your team's tournament schedule.*
- NorCal Fall League begins in Aug.
- NorCal State Cup starts in Aug.
- DV CYSA League begins in Sept. (teams may only play in one league)

December:

- Christmas break in mid or late Dec.

January:

- Practice 2-3x/week, possibly 1-2 tournament competitions
- U14 CYSA Winter League (teams may only opt to play in one league)
- CYSA State Cup except U14 which runs March - April
- NorCAL State Cup continues

February:

- CYSA State Cup competition ends except U14
- NorCal State Cup ends

- All practice, leagues, tournaments, and breaks scheduling subject to individual coach and team
- Coaches may choose to participate in either CYSA District V or U.S. Club Soccer sponsored NorCal leagues.
- Coaches may choose to participate in either CYSA State Cup or U.S. Club Soccer sponsored NorCal State Cup.

Payment options:

- 1: Pay in full at registration \$1,365
- 2: Monthly payments: 1st installment of \$340 with 11 monthly payments of \$95 due June 1, 2010 – April 1, 2011
- 3: Pay annual fees in four payments: 1st installment of \$440 with three more payments of \$315 due June 1, Aug. 1, Oct. 1

Annual Club Fee \$1,520

Payment options:

- 1: Pay in full at registration \$1,500
- 2: Monthly payments: 1st installment of \$475 with 11 monthly payments of \$95 due June 1, 2010 – April 1, 2011
- 3: Pay annual fees in four payments: 1st installment of \$455 with three more payments of \$355 due June 1, Aug. 1, Oct. 1
